# Healthy School Award

In line with our Healthy Schools Award, snacks for morning break time should be a healthy snack – not crisps or chocolate biscuits/bars. Pupils are allowed to bring in water bottles to keep themselves hydrated throughout the day but these should be filled with water not juice.

# School Uniform

We are very proud of how smart our children look in their school uniforms and would like this to continue. However there are a couple of points, I would like to remind parents about:

- trousers and skirts should be grey not black
- skirts should not be excessively short
- earrings should be removed
- nail varnish should not be worn
- pupils should not have extreme hair styles including tramline lines/designs shaved into hair or have dyed hair and hair accessories should be small and blue to match in with our uniform.

Please see the school uniform list below. We do have items of donated uniform available at the school office, if anyone requires anything.

- Grey trousers/skirt/pinafore, pale blue polo shirt, school sweatshirt/cardigan, black school shoes (not trainers).
- PE Kit White t-shirt/Royal Blue shorts
   Black or Navy Joggers (for colder days), Black Plimsolls/Trainers.
   No logo (eg Nike, Addidas etc) items of clothing for PE thank you.
- Jewellery, including earrings, are not permitted to be worn. Pupils can wear a wrist watch.
- Makeup/Nail varnish are not permitted to be worn.

# Attendance & Punctuality

- The school day starts at 8.55am with the school doors opening at 8.45am.
- Registers are taken from 8.55am and will remain open for 30 minutes.
- Any pupils arriving after 9am will be marked as 'late before register closes'.
- Any pupil arriving after the register closes will be marked as an unauthorised absence.
- Please note that holidays should not be taken in term time and will not be authorised; if a holiday is taken and meets the new threshold of 10 sessions\* within a period of 10 weeks, we may refer the matter to the Local Authority who may issue a penalty notice. The penalty notice has increased to £80 per parent, per child.
