Year 2 Summer Term 2

English

This half term in English, we are beginning with a narrative unit. We will be writing a tale of fear. This will be followed by an explanation text. In phonics we will be revising a variety of sounds including le, il, al, el, y as well as adding suffixes. In reading we will be developing fluency, retrieval and inference skills using a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts.



Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about what it is like in Rajasthan, India. We will be locating Rajasthan on a map. Then we will look at the physical features of Rajasthan. We will be using aerial photographs to recognise landmarks and physical features. We will be learning about the weather in Rajasthan. Next we will be learning about what life is like for people in Rajasthan. Finally, we will be listing some differences between Rajasthan and the UK.

Science


In Science, we will become scientists using the outdoors as resources. We will work scientifically to carry out a number of experiments including, which ingredients can be used to make the best bubbles, how to make a rainbow and which ball bounces the highest. We will observe closely, make predictions and record our findings in a variety of ways.

RE

In RE, our first topic will be about rules, learning about The Sacrament of Reconciliation, we will understand how Christians try to practise Jesus' commandment of love, peace and reconciliation. In our final topic, entitled Treasures, we will make links between religious stories about creation and treasuring our world and beliefs.

Maths

This half term, we will start by learning about measures include mass, capacity and temperature. We will then revisit number sequences and consolidate our learning around the four operations. We will spend time working out how to solve two step problems using thinking skills and reasoning.

Art

In Art, we will be looking at the work of various artists and techniques, including Picasso and Georges Braque. We will create drawing and painting collages in their particular style.

PSHE/RSE

This term our unit is 'Created to Live in Community' it explores the children's relationship with the wider world. We will explore how human beings are relational by nature and are called to love others in the wider community through service, through dialogue and through working for the Common Good.

In PE, we will be learning skills linked to hit, catch and run. We will be working on a variety of ways to score runs in the different hit, catch and run games.

Computing

This half term in computing, we will be exploring Keeping Safe and Exploring Technology. We will be looking at how we can keep ourselves safe online.
